

WALLS/PANELING/WALLPAPER (LARGE AREAS)

Tools Needed

- Properly Equipped 2-Button Dilution Center
- Large Bucket
- Clean Towels



Product Needed

Dawn® Manual Pot and Pan Detergent

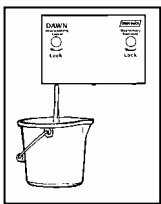


FREQUENCY OF CLEANING: Weekly or as needed.

SPECIAL DIRECTIONS FOR THIS TASK: If sensitivity to cleaning solutions is a concern, wear rubber gloves.

STEP 1

NOTE: This method pertains to cleaning large wall areas or tile, plastic coated or painted surfaces, wallpaper or finished wood areas.

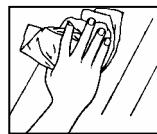


- Fill large bucket half full with Dawn from the Dilution Center.



STEP 2

- Immerse clean towel in bucket and remove, wringing out excess water.



STEP 3

- Starting at the bottom of the wall, wash upward with wet towel to the top to catch any runs or drips.

CAUTION: Do not use on electrical outlets and switches to avoid shock.



NOTE: Rinse and wring towel out frequently in bucket to ensure good cleaning. Replace solution if it becomes heavily soiled or suds are gone.



STEP 4

- If used, remove and discard disposable gloves.
- Wash hands before returning to service area.
